



Welcome to B+B York, we're delighted that you and your pet have decided to stay with us! Before we get you checked in we'd just like to inform you of our 'Paws Policy'.

Unfortunately some of our pet guests have not been as "house-trained" as we would have hoped and we have incurred some pet soiling which is unpleasant for other guests and expensive to clean up.

As a result of our past experiences it is now our policy to ask for a pet deposit (excuse the pun!) to cover any unexpected eventualities. We hope you understand?

- A £50 fully refundable pet deposit will be added to all "pet-occupied" rooms.
- We allow two small dogs or one large dog in a room.
- No stray pets allowed so please don't leave them unattended at any time.
- Guide dogs are our honoured guests and therefore have free access.
- The breakfast room and the guest lounge during breakfast service is out of bounds for our pet guests.
- Guard-dogging duties (growling, snarling and barking) must be restricted to the carpark so as not to disrupt our human guests.
- The same rules apply for pets and humans – no eating off the table. Humans must use a knife and fork. Dogs must eat in their room.
- If you require a pet sitting service, ask us, and we will put you in touch with one of our recommended pet-sitters.
- Whilst we do allow pets in our pet-friendly rooms, we kindly ask our furry buddies to refrain from relaxing on human beds. Pets are not permitted on the first and second floor in the main building.
- If your pet gets too excited for words, they'll probably be asked to go and get excited outside.
- We love to keep our rooms clean, so if you are staying over, we will require access to the room between breakfast and 2pm.
- All dogs must be charming to our staff, please let them know they are not snacks to eat.
- Dogs are not allowed to poop in humans' homes. The same goes for us. If they want to "go", they must be accompanied outside and their humans are as usual, responsible for the consequential pooper scooping...
- The humans who are with the Pet guests are fully responsible for the repair or replacement of any items soiled or damaged by their pets.
- Trusting our pet guests are happy with their stay and complied with the above, the £50 pet deposit will be refunded.

Places nearby to walk the dog

Clifton Green

At the end of the road turn right. Keep walking straight along Bootham and on your left hand side you will see a small green.

Museum Gardens

Turn left at the end of St Peter's Grove, walk along Bootham until you come to the top of Marygate. Walk down to the bottom and on the left hand side you will see an entrance into the Museum Gardens.

River Bank

Turn right onto Bootham, follow the instructions for Clifton green then go by the Grey Mare pub follow the road around. This path will take you all the way to the river or to the city center.

Places to visit nearby with the dog

Castle Howard is a stately home in North Yorkshire, England, 15 miles north of York. It is a private residence, and has been the home of the Carlisle branch of the Howard family for more than 300 years.

"Dogs are welcome in the Castle Howard grounds as long as they are kept on a lead at all times, bins are provided for dog waste so please pick up. Dogs are not permitted in the adventure playground or house, with the exception of assistance dogs. Dogs are welcome at the outdoor seating areas at our cafés and water bowls are provided. Free bones are available from the farm shop, subject to availability."
